

## COLLEGE EVALUATION FEES AND OTHER ASSESSMENTS

The fee schedule was last revised during the October 2024 Council meeting with immediate implementation. Fees are not refundable.

<b>Fee</b>	<b>Explanation of Fees and Charges</b>
<b>Applicant Status</b>	An institution applying to be a new college of podiatric medicine or a college that has had accreditation withdrawn and is seeking to regain accreditation is assessed an initial application fee of <b>\$5,000</b> .
<b>Candidate Status Application</b>	An institution seeking candidate status of a new college of podiatric medicine is assessed an application fee of <b>\$10,000</b> .
<b>Preaccreditation</b>	An institution seeking preaccreditation of a new college of podiatric medicine is assessed a fee of <b>\$10,000</b> .
<b>On-Site Evaluation</b>	An institution to be evaluated by the Council is responsible for paying the full and actual costs associated with all on-site evaluation visits. The fee includes reimbursement for evaluator expenses along with the cost of meeting facilities, if necessary. Payment of a <b>\$15,000</b> preassessment is requested from the institution prior to each evaluation visit. The institution is billed for any costs beyond the preassessment following the visit.
<b>Annual Assessment</b>	Institutions are assessed an annual continuation fee of <b>\$6,000</b> .
<b>Appeal of an Adverse Action</b>	Any college requesting to appeal an adverse action will be billed <b>\$10,000</b> prior to the appeal. Colleges are billed for any additional costs over <b>\$10,000</b> following the appeal.
