Brief History since the Last Comprehensive Evaluation:

April 2021

Based on review of the comprehensive report of the evaluation team and the college's written response to the team report, the Council granted accreditation of New York College of Podiatric Medicine through April 2026. On-site re-evaluation may be expected during the fall of 2025 or early winter 2026. The maximum first year class enrollment for the institution is 109.

Following review of the on-site team report, the Accreditation Committee and the Council determined that the college is in noncompliance with one standard and requirement from CPME 120, *Standards and Requirements for Accrediting Colleges of Podiatric Medicine*: Standard 1 Requirement D, Ongoing Evaluation Process. The college is required to submit a progress report for consideration at the fall 2021 meetings of the Accreditation Committee and the Council that includes the college's progress in correcting the area of noncompliance.

October 2021

Following review of the progress report, the Accreditation Committee and the Council determined that the college remains in noncompliance with Standard 1 Requirement D, Ongoing Evaluation Process, from CPME 120, *Standards and Requirements for Accrediting Colleges of Podiatric Medicine*. The college is required to submit a progress report for consideration at the spring 2022 meetings of the Accreditation Committee and the Council that includes the college's progress in correcting the area of noncompliance.

April 2022

Following review of the progress report, the Accreditation Committee and the Council determined that the college remains in noncompliance with Standard 1 Requirement D, Ongoing Evaluation Process, from CPME 120, *Standards and Requirements for Accrediting Colleges of Podiatric Medicine*. The college is required to submit a progress report for consideration at the fall 2022 meetings of the Accreditation Committee and the Council that includes the college's progress in correcting the area of noncompliance.

October and November 2022

Following review of the progress report, the Accreditation Committee and the Council determined that the college remains in noncompliance with Standard 1 Requirement D, Ongoing Evaluation Process, from CPME 120, *Standards and Requirements for Accrediting Colleges of Podiatric Medicine*. The college is required to submit a progress report for consideration at the spring 2023 meetings of the Accreditation Committee and the Council that includes the college's progress in correcting the area of noncompliance. The accreditation action from the October 2022 meeting has been rescinded because the college submitted a request for an extension of time to demonstrate compliance with the accreditation standard which, after due consideration, the Council determined there was good cause to grant.

April 2023

The area of noncompliance (Standard 1 Requirement D) related to Ongoing Evaluation Process has been **corrected**.

Concerning the substantive change request to merge with Touro University, the Accreditation Committee and Council reviewed and granted preliminary approval of the substantive change request at the April 2021 meeting until such time that CPME can conduct an on-site evaluation when the affiliation is operational. The college reports that it is currently awaiting final approvals.

The college is in compliance with all accreditation standards and requirements.

May 2025

Based on review of the focused report of the evaluation team, the school's written response to the team report, and the presentation to the Accreditation Committee on May 1, 2025, the Council fully approved the substantive change of the acquisition of the NYCPM by Touro University following the focused site visit conducted on March 31, 2025. The Committee and Council determined that there are no outstanding issues and no further follow-up is required. The substantive change in ownership procedures have been completed. NYCPM of Touro University is scheduled for a required site visit by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education in June 2025 before the acquisition is finalized.
